



Adult Support Groups

Laois LGBT+ Social and Support Group

Our social meetups are for anyone over 18 who identifies as LGBT+ or are questioning their sexuality or gender. It is a relaxed informal space to meet others. It is group led meaning you decide what happens whether that is an informal chat, a walk or a workshop. The group meets monthly in different parts of Laois depending on the activity happening that month.

Offaly LGBT+ Social and Support Group

Our newest social group is a monthly group for LGBT+ adults in Offaly who want to make friends, get support and do different activities from hiking to cinema trips or dinners and everything in between.

LGBT+ Book Club

Another new group, our queer book club is in demand and had a waiting list of members even before its first meet up. It is a virtual group where members pick an LGBT+ related book each month to read and discuss.

Trans Midlands Peer Support Group

Trans Midlands is a group for anyone over 18 in the midlands who is transgender, non binary, intersex or questioning. The group is a safe peer support and social space for our members to meet others, share experiences and seek support from their peers.

Midlands Parents of LGBT+ Young People Group

Parents of LGBT+ Young People Group is an informal group for parents/ carers/ family members of LGBT+ young people looking for advice and support. The group communicate virtually and Midlands LGBT+ Project has quarterly workshops for them on different topics or areas that they are interested in.


